

Change Is In The Air

Many collaboration realities are shifting...

- The days of the Half-Million Dollar collaboration room are over
- Small integrators are merging into larger ones The AV integration industry is shrinking as systems become easier
- Collaboration costs are down
- Collaboration reliability is up
- Loyalty to providers is still strong, but not as locked-in as it was before
- User organizations are pivoting from measuring "successful calls" to measuring business value



Metrics *How do you measure success...*


- Collaboration metrics are evolving
 - Complete calls w/o failures (early 2000)
 - Actual utilization (~2010)
 - Determining actual business value (today)






Interoperability *Why can't I call you...*

- The break-up of the Bell System
 - Calling no longer managed by a monopoly
- Coopetition
 - Firms want to be seen as working together, but in reality would rather see other firms go up in flames
- Standards
 - Always correct in the first person ("Our Standards") but never correct in the third person ("Their Standards")
 - Too many pick whichever ones you like
- Outbreaks of "Kumbaya" develop, then inevitably disintegrate

Actually more than one...

- Telephony was developed under a monopoly (AT&T The Bell System)
- When the bell system was broken-up, it was every firm for itself
- There is no incentive for any firm to work together with any other firm, other than wanting to appear in public like they're willing to. The more likely reality is – in private – they all want to see their competitors come to an untimely end.
